Single Mom Wronged – Parenting Rights Restored

Chicago, IL, December 28 - Leading family law attorney Andrey Filipowicz from the Law Offices of Jeffery M. The mother's parenting time was unfairly suspended without a court order by the parenting coordinator because the mother did not want to take an invasive psychological test.
